

# Case Management Support Service

## About the service

The Case Management Support Service (CMSS) is a comprehensive, impartial service that will offer support to Scottish governing bodies of sport (SGBs) to manage and investigate child and adult wellbeing and protection concerns or complaints. This service was commissioned by **sportscotland** and awarded to Children 1st who currently deliver the Child Wellbeing and Protection in Sport Service (CWPS).

The focus of this new service is to enable SGBs to have an effective system for the investigative process and disciplinary & appeal hearings. CMSS will provide a range of resources and guides for all SGBs, as well as offer training, mentoring, and learning opportunities.

Four organisations have been identified to be part of a pilot for CMSS including, Scottish Disability Sport, Scottish Rowing, Scottish Student Sport, and Scottish Swimming. This pilot will help us test out the preparatory stages required for the CMSS to support live cases in partnership with organisations and build the capacity of SGB staff and volunteers.
